Content Requirements

- 1 paragraph introduction: summary of the film, definition of the term "resurrection" and "journey", thesis statement to introduce topic of the essay.
- 3-4 body paragraphs, each including one cited quotation from the film, and explanation of the quotation, and how the quotation shows the theme of resurrection and/or journey.
- A conclusion, consisting of a one-sentence closing statement.
